1. Introduction

2. Event Rules and Specifications

2.1. Eligibility

Any student from a recognized institute/college can participate in this event.

2.2. Team Size

- Only team entries are eligible
- A team may consist of maximum 3 members. Students from different colleges cannot form a team.
- The students must carry valid student ID cards of their college which they will be required to produce at the time of registration.

2.3. Rules

1. The decision of the quiz-master will be final and will not be subjected to any change
2. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments
3. Audience shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors

4. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration

2.4. Event Structure

The event will consist of the following rounds:

1. Round 1 - Preliminary

- A set of twenty questions will be asked from each of the participating teams
- The top six teams with the maximum score will advance to the next round

2. Round 2 - General

- Each team will be asked 2 questions of 10 marks each. They will be given 30 seconds for each question
- If the allotted team is unable to answer the question, then the question will be passed on to the subsequent teams
- Subsequent teams will be given 15 seconds to answer & will be awarded 5 marks for each correct answer

3. Round 3 – Flipper

- Each team will be asked 2 questions of 10 marks each. They will be given 30 seconds for each question
- 15 marks will be awarded for each correct answer & 5 marks will be deducted for each incorrect answer
- The question will not be passed on to the subsequent teams in case the allotted team is unable to answer

4. Round 4- Rapid Round

5. Each team will be given a set of ten question to answer within 60 seconds
6. 5 marks will be awarded for each correct answer

****IN CASE THERE IS A TIE BETWEEN TWO OR MORE TEAMS, THEN A TIE BREAKER ROUND WILL BE CONDUCTED**

All decisions taken by the organizing team will be deemed as final, and no more changes will be encouraged, thus holding the full authority to change any of the above rules as per circumstances.
